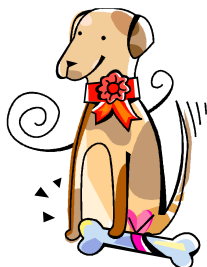

Dogs under the age of 6 months cannot enter any class

Heelwork to Music (Ring 5) There will be two judges per class.

Dogs must be over 9 months

Rosettes 1st to 6th places. **Toys and titbits allowed in all HTM classes**

31. First Timers Dogs can be on lead From 11:30am

32. Mainly Heelwork From 12:15pm

33. Mainly Freestyle

34. Anything goes

35. Training rounds (not judged) This class will be free to anyone entering classes 31 to 34 but others must pay the class fee.

Heelwork to Music Rules

1. First timer means neither the person nor the dog have ever competed at a show. Routines can be heelwork or freestyle, Please indicate on entry form.
2. Anything goes is for any single handler or team or any combination of dogs and handlers. Routines can be heelwork or freestyle.
3. The time limit for all routines is 4mins.
4. No harsh handling.
5. The music must be on a tape or disc with the position or track clearly labelled. It must be given to the ring steward before the class starts.
6. Routines will be judged out of 30:- Programme Content 10 marks. Accuracy and Execution of Movement 10 marks. Musical Interpretation 10 marks. Time fault loses 2 marks.
7. The judges decision is final.
8. Moves that may be harmful to the dog will be penalise.
9. **Dogs must be over 9 months old.**
10. Heelwork means a dog working off lead in the heel work position, on the left or right hand side of the handler, facing forward or backward, across the front or back of the handler, moving in any direction, at any pace. The dog's shoulder should be approximately level with, and reasonably close to the handler's leg. All other positions are defined as Freestyle.
